

Hey There!

Below is the list of Japanese Gel Nail Products you should have to follow along in the MGN Course.

In the training, I am using primarily Leafgel, but because I didn't want you to feel like you had no other choice, I included Vetro, and Kokoist products that are comparable to what I use in the training. I've been using these brands consistently for 5+ years. Just compare each brand horizontally across!

I strongly recommend (especially if you're just starting with Japanese Gel) that you stick to one brand's clear gels in the beginning. Use their clear gels for about 1-3 months exclusively, before layering brands. This will ensure you really get a feel for the brand, before committing or pitching it. Colors, you can mix and match brands they all "play" very well together!

(My favorite brand's color are primarily Kokoist and Vetro, last is Leafgel 🧑‍🎨♀️)

Personally when it comes to potted gels, I like to designate brushes to key gels, so that I can avoid "contaminating them". These are the potted gels I assign their own brush to (... and I usually do prefer a rounded brush over a flat):

- ❖ Top Gel
- ❖ Base Gel (I don't have 1 brush for each base, just 1 brush for any of my bases)
- ❖ Builder Gel (I like a firmer texture brush that allows me to use it as a "scoop", i.e. Kokoist Round or Thin Round)
- ❖ Glitter Gel
- ❖ Color Gel (some do a brush for light colors, and another one for dark)

I do currently have codes for you to save 10% from Leafgel or Kokoist, and 3 times a year I'm allowed a bulk buy sale from Vetro (you can email me for 15% off an order of \$100+)...
